

WHITE WATER RAFTING TRIP

Where: Lower Youghiogheny River (approx. 1.5 hours south of Pittsburgh, PA)

When: July 29-31, 2005

Cost: Approx. US\$ 125 (including whitewater rafting trip, meals on Saturday and Sunday brunch, and accommodation)

RSVP Date: Before June 18, 2005

This trip is open to all Z-youth in North America, aged 16-35 as of July 29th. The Lower Yough is an intermediate whitewater rafting trip (class III and IV), and is suitable for beginners in good shape and experienced rafters. We will be hosted by the Zoroastrian Association of Pittsburgh (ZAPA).

Schedule:

July 29 - Arrive into Pittsburgh (evening)

July 30 - Whitewater rafting in the morning & afternoon; evening activity in Pittsburgh

July 31 - Brunch; departure from Pittsburgh

The rafting trip on Saturday has 20 spots, so these will be allocated on a first-come basis. Other options for Saturday will be kayaking, biking, boating and hiking (for those who want to come but not go whitewater rafting), and the cost will be adjusted accordingly.
